Qualifications, Eligibility & Responsibilities

The purpose of the junior princess contest is to raise the interest level for the National Maine-Anjou Queen contest as well as raising awareness and activity levels of younger AJMMA members. Junior princesses will be selected at the National Junior Maine-Anjou Show. The current AJMMA Board along with the AMAA National Maine-Anjou Queen will act as the selection committee. Two princesses will be selected.

Contest Guidelines

- Applicant must be in good standing with the AJMMA. (Dues paid member)
- Participated in one previous National Junior Maine-Anjou Show.
- Applicant must be between the ages of 10 and 13.
- Applicant must show an active interest in raising and promoting Maine-Anjou cattle.

Application Requirements

- Complete online application by May 2, 2022.

Responsibilities

- Assist the National Maine-Anjou Queen and AJMMA Board of Director's during the National Junior Maine-Anjou Show.
- Fill in for the queen when needed (attend shows and breed functions with queen when possible).
- Appear in official dress at shows and industry functions when representing the breed awards.

Awards

- All participants will be recognized at the National Junior Maine-Anjou Show banquet.
- Tiara and sash will be provided.

Official Dress

- Official dress is khaki dress pants or dark jeans with a white button up shirt, jacket, boots, belt, sash and tiara.
