It is with great pleasure that I welcome you to the American Maine-Anjou Association's National Western Bright Lights Bull and Female Sale! It's an honor for me to have this opportunity to update everyone and share with you the positive benefits that the Maine-Anjou breed has to offer the commercial cattlemen.

Today's commercial producers often ask the question, "What genetics best fits my program to meet my marketing end point needs?" This is an extremely important question because it affects profitability of everyone's operations for years to come. I suggest to producers to step back and reevaluate your program and select the genetics to elevate the traits that need improvement. When producers consider a breed that can meet or exceed all traits from maternal strength to winning carcasses on the rail, the Maine-Anjou breed can "aggressively compete" in all phases of cattle production.

"Crossbreeding" has become the "buzz" word in the cattle industry as producers are looking for ways to improve their cow calf efficiency and profitability.
