Entry Deadline: November 20 - All entries must be submitted online through the AMAA website.

DNA Submission Deadline: November 20

Photos and Video Due: December 1

Sale Day: January 14, 2022 on SC Online Sales

ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS

- Eligibility: Active AMAA adult and junior members are eligible to consign to this sale.
- Entry Submission: All entries for the Power in the Pens sale will be submitted online at maine-anjou.org.
- Entry Fee: \$250 (sale expense)
- Commission: 8% commission.

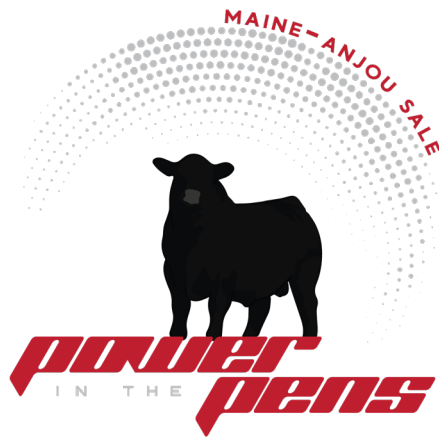
Consignments that go through the sale will have the yard charges deducted from your sale settlement.

Sales commission will apply to any total "No Sale" prices.

Entry fees are non-refundable.

Substitutions: \$50 per head.

- The following minimums must be met to be eligible for the Power in the Pens Sale.
 - WDA at a minimum of 2.5 lbs (Bulls) and 2 lbs (Females).
 - Scrotal minimum of 28 c.m. on bulls under a year of age and 30 c.m. over a year of age.
 - Birthweight – bulls with a birthweight of 100 lbs are not eligible for the Power in the Pens sale.
- Bulls that do not reach the specified measurements may be screened from the sale. Entry fees of screened bulls are non-refundable.
 - Screened bulls will be charged a yard fee to be paid by consignor to the National Western Stock Show.
- The number of bulls sold will not be set at a certain number.



INFORMATION

MAINE ANGUS

· Maine Angus – All Maine Angus animals eligible for sale must meet the Maine Angus color and testing requirements. Additionally, all Maine Angus testing must be submitted by November 20, 2021 or they will be listed as Mainefainers.

All Maine Angus nominations must have a photo submitted with entry to verify color. (Bulls & Heifers).

· Data: Scrotal circumference, WDA and ultrasound data will be made available on every sale bull.

HEALTH & DNA

· DNA: All DNA must be submitted by November 20.

The sample must be at the NeoGen lab by November 20th in order to receive results back before the sale. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Testing will take at least 3 - 4 weeks to receive results.

All genetic lots must meet AMAA DNA requirements.

DNA may be pulled for purposes of parent verification. (At the discretion of AMAA).

· Health Certificate: An individual health certificate must accompany every consignment, made in quadruplicate and leaving blank the consignee and destination spaces. Each animal must meet the health regulations set by the state of Colorado for interstate shipment.

· Veterinary Service: Will aid at check-in. Consignments suspected of unethical practices will be disqualified.

· Semen Test: Every bull 14 months or older at the time of the sale must have a satisfactory semen evaluation. A semen evaluation certificate must accompany the health certificate.

· Bred Females: Bred females must have written confirmation of pregnancy from a veterinarian.

· Payment: All AMAA past due accounts will be deducted from consignor prior to payment.
