



### **SHOW ANIMAL OF THE YEAR POINT SEASON**

The point season will run from March 2024 to March 2025. Points will be awarded for all open Maine-Anjou shows that were reported to the American Maine-Anjou Association (AMAA) office during that time, as reported by that show's office. Shows of less than 40 head receive half points, shows of more than 40 head receive full points, while animals exhibited at the American Royal, Kansas City, Mo., North American International Livestock Exposition, Louisville, Ky., and Cattlemen's Congress, Oklahoma City, Okla., receive double points. A top Gold, Silver & Bronze animal will be awarded in each breed category (Fullblood, Maine-Anjou, Maine Angus, MaineTainer).

In order to qualify for the All American program, animals must be exhibited at a minimum of two double point shows. Breeders and owners of cattle are listed according to the AMAA database during the point season.

Fullblood, Maine Angus and MaineTainer points are figured separately. For instance, if you show at one show that has a Maine Angus division but show at another one that shows them as MaineTainers, you will have two separate point tallies. Same applies for Fullbloods.

Shows less than 40 head receive ½ points.

Animals must be ¾ or higher percentage to be eligible.

### **TABULATION OF PREMIER EXHIBITOR/BREEDER POINTS AT THE FOUR MAJOR SHOWS:**

#### **EXHIBITOR POINTS:**

1. Exhibitor points will be awarded to owner of record (to include immediate family national junior association members) as per AMAA computer at the time of the show.
2. An animal that is co-owned, the points will be tabulated as follows
  - If only one owner is present with cattle, they will be awarded all the points that animal acquires
  - If multiple owners are present, points will be divided equally.

#### **BREEDER POINTS:**

Breeder points will be awarded to breeder of record.

For publication purposes, cattle will be listed as per AMAA computer. Any cattle sold will have until next magazine deadline for transfer to take place and be published as such.
