## MAINE-ANJOU REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

**MINIMUM FRACTION REQUIREMENT:** Animals must be at least 1/4 Maine-Anjou to be eligible for registration.

**COMMERCIAL ANIMALS:** Any animal not registered with the AMAA is considered commercial.

**BULLS:** The sire must be registered Maine-Anjou or have a commercial number on file with AMAA. If the sire is from another breed, his pedigree must be submitted and placed on file with AMAA for a \$40 fee (if not already recorded).

**STEERS:** Eligible for registration if they are at least 1/4 Maine-Anjou. Steers may be registered out of commercial sires.

**BRED & OWNED ANIMALS:** To qualify, the dam must be registered—either with AMAA or another recognized breed association. The person registering must also own the dam. Unregistered dams will not qualify offspring as bred and owned.

### PAPER CLASSIFICATIONS:

**MAINTAINER** - (Green papers): 1/4, 3/8, 1/2, and 5/8

**HIGH MAINE** - (Brown papers): 3/4, 7/8 (Purebred), and 100% (Fullblood).

**MAINE ANGUS** - (Blue papers): 3/8, 1/2, and 5/8  
Maine Angus papers are marked "MaineTainer" in the center with a Maine Angus logo in the top right corner. Maine Angus cattle may show in MaineTainer classes if a specific Maine-Angus class is not offered. See the AMAA website for full Maine-Angus qualification requirements.

\*\* Any unregistered dam or sire must obtain a commercial number to register. Pedigrees from other Associations may be added for a onetime fee of \$25/ dams and \$40/sires.
